ECCCH 2024 – European Collaborative Cloud for Cultural Heritage

- Create a European **digital collaborative working space** designed according to the needs of **cultural heritage researchers and professionals**
- **Unlock the opportunities of the digital transition** to Europe's cultural heritage institutions and heritage research organisations
- Contribute to **make European cultural heritage world leaders in using digital technologies** to the benefit of society



Three phase support by Horizon Europe → ECCCH

WP 2023
Design and implement the basic architecture, data model and governance, including steering and coordination entity for all implementation actions

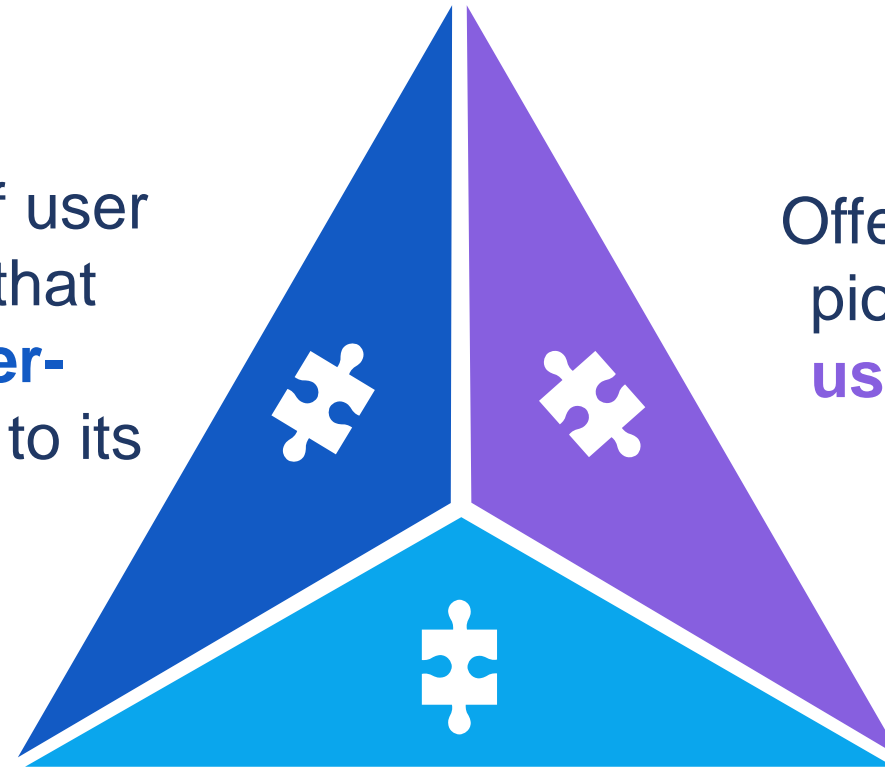
WP 2024
Research and develop **basic tools** and **functionality** that make the platform attractive, useful and user friendly

WP 2025
Develop and test **real world users** of the platform together with stakeholders; pilot, test, improve, integrate



Purpose of the WP 2024

Develop an initial set of user tools on the ECCCH that makes it **useful, user-friendly** and **powerful** to its target users



Offer **attractive services** to pioneering users, **easy to use** and corresponding to **real needs**

Exploit the **network effect** and **power of the platform** to exponentially **add value** as **more users** and **data accumulate**

Five call topics focusing on 10 areas:

Scope

- Develop and implement a set of innovative tools and methods on the ECCCH based on the digital twins of cultural heritage objects stored in the ECCCH, for the study, conservation and restoration of cultural heritage objects.
- Concrete applications of these tools and methods provided for at least
 - Supporting the study of cultural heritage objects
 - Supporting conservation and restoration works

Expect to fund 2 projects

For all call topics



- ✓ **Lump sum** funding & raised page limit to **60 pages** – applicants should take this into account
- ✓ **Financial Support to Third Parties** is allowed – a possibility to engage more users beyond consortium members
- ✓ **Software developed to be Open Source** – unless strong reasons against, and then under special conditions
- ✓ **Software developed according to ECCCH standards** – to be integrated into the platform
- ✓ **Wide user engagement expected** – tools and methods to be developed in close collaboration with actively involved representative target users
- ✓ **Projects funded under the same topic expected to coordinate** – to ensure synergies and complementarities
- ✓ **All projects to coordinate with the ECCCH ‘platform project’** – and use its common website
- ✓ ...and more – **read the topic text carefully!**
- ✓ Call to **open 18 June 2024**, deadline **22 January 2025**
